Service members you may qualify if:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- You are a current Lawful Permanent Resident (Green Card holder)
- You can pass a **reading, writing and civics** exam or qualify for an exemption
- Demonstrate **good moral character**

Service Requirements:

The applicant must have served honorably at any time in the US. Armed forces for a period or periods totaling at least 1 year during designated peace times OR served any time during a designated period of hostility

Special considerations:

- **Expedited Citizenship:** under certain circumstances.
- **Waived Residency Requirements**
- **No State Residency Requirement**
